


## **Installation Instructions for Maps from GPSTravelMaps.com (for Mac)**

Note: The following instructions are for viewing and installing maps using a computer running the Mac OS X operating system. ### **Step 1**

Once purchase of map is complete, you will receive an order receipt. Click on the ZIP file to begin your map download. \*\*\*Notice your map password above download links.\*\*\*



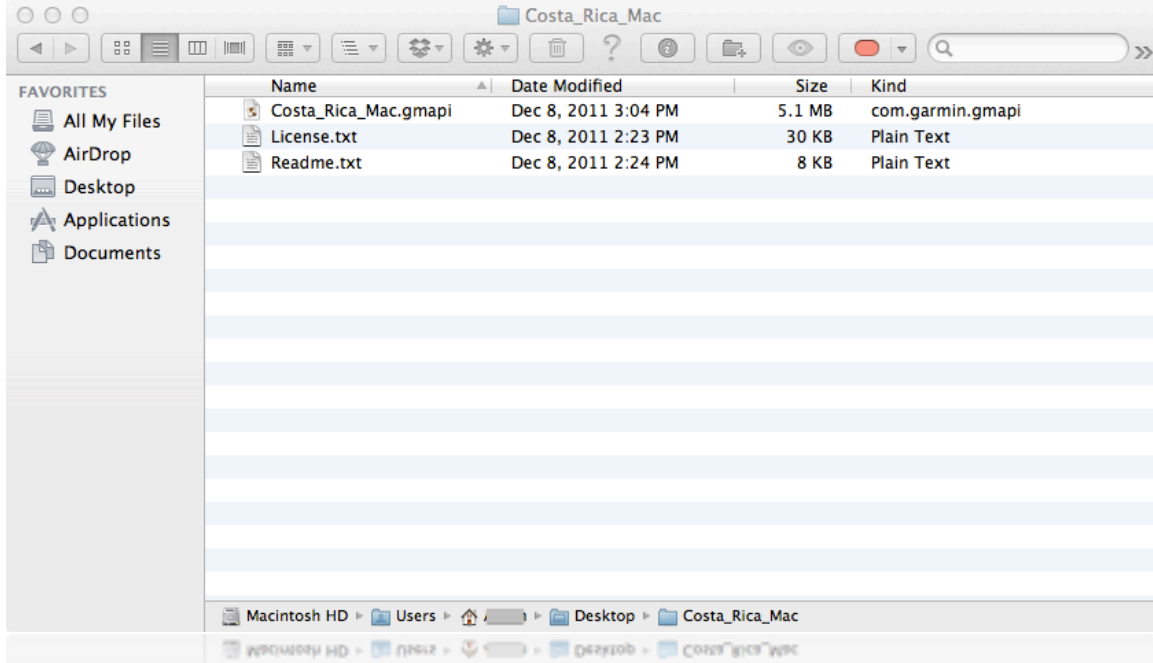

### **Step 2**

It will download as a ZIP file; unzip the file (double-click on it).

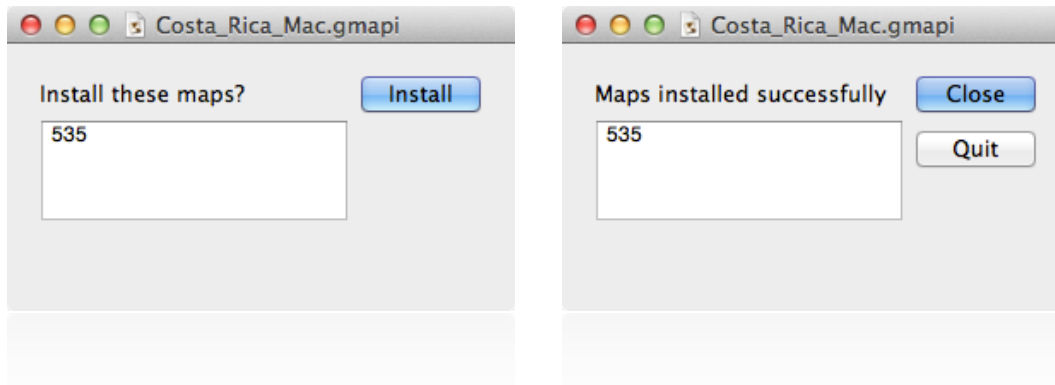
You will see a file with a .gmapi extension. Double-click on this file to begin installation. (The other files you see are the license agreement and version history in the readme document.)

### **Step 3**

When you double click on the .gmapi file, Garmin MapManager software will open. Click INSTALL. Afterwards you will see a dialogue box that says "*Maps installed successfully*". You can now close these windows (and use Cmd-Q to close MapManager).



You have installed your map onto your computer and are now ready to view it in Basecamp Trip & Waypoint Manager.
